Arkansas Society for Respiratory Care 2013 State & District Practitioner of the Year Awards Rules & Regulations

As health care professionals, respiratory care practitioners must strive, both individually and collectively, to maintain high standards. The ASRC is now accepting nominations for its annual practitioner awards. The ASRC would like to recognize an outstanding respiratory care at the state level and an outstanding respiratory care practitioner from each of the four (4) ASRC districts – Central, Northeast, Northwest, and South. These awards recognize respiratory care practitioners who exhibit professionalism, technical strengths, leadership, and care for humanity.

I. Personal Ethics.

- A. The nominee should provide service with compassion and respect the rights of others.
- B. The nominee should practice medically acceptable methods of treatment and should not endeavor to extend his/her practice beyond his/her competence and the authority vested in him/her by the physician.
- C. The nominee should continually strive to increase and improve his/her knowledge and skills.
- D. The nominee should be responsible for the competent and efficient performance of his/her assigned duties and should expose incompetence and illegal or unethical conduct of other RCP's.
- E. The nominee should uphold the dignity and honor of the profession and abide by its ethical principles. He/She should be familiar with existing state and federal laws governing the practice of respiratory care and comply with those laws.
- F. The nominee should be willing to cooperate with other health care professionals and assume responsibility to participate in activities that promote community and national response to health needs.

II. Membership Representation to the AARC/ASRC.

- A. The nominee must be an <u>ACTIVE</u> member of the AARC/ASRC in good standing. Associate, Foreign, Physician, or Student members are <u>INELIGIBLE</u> for nomination.
- B. Please list any ASRC offices or ASRC Committee work performed by the nominee.

III. Support of the Respiratory Care Profession.

- A. The nominee should support legal recognition efforts.
- B. The nominee should support public recognition efforts.
- C. The nominee should support community service activities.
