

Arkansas Society for Respiratory Care Educator of the Year

The Educator of the Year Award is presented to an individual who has enhanced the image of the Respiratory Care profession and has contributed to quality patient care through his or her role in the education of Respiratory Care professionals.

Award Eligibility Criteria:

- Candidates must be an active member of the ASRC.
- Candidates must have demonstrated activities beneficial to the profession in the current year to be considered for this award.
- Candidates must have consistently demonstrated contributions to education and student development.
- The candidate must be nominated by a peer (educator, school administrator, etc.) Student nominations will not be accepted.
- Nominations must include a maximum 500-word essay explaining why the educator is the best in the field.
- The essay and nomination form must be postmarked by August 1st.
- The candidate must be an employee of an accredited school (part time or full time).

Qualified candidates will be notified of their nomination and are responsible for providing the following documentation:

- Current curriculum vitae
- ASRC membership verification

Educator Selection

All submitted applications will be presented to a five-member educator committee in anonymous fashion. Identifying information will be removed. The committee will select the award recipient.
